Dear Provincial Sections,

The purpose of this letter is to inform you that Masters Swimming Ontario and all and any participants, members or events related to Masters Swimming Ontario are in not in good standing and are subsequently suspended from any sanctioned actively both domestically and internationally.

This action is in follow up to a letter received by Swimming Canada on June 19, 2015 from the President of Swim Ontario notifying that Masters Swimming Ontario is no longer a member-in-good-standing.

This letter also serves as notification that the Masters Swimming National Championship set to begin on May 20th, 2016 is not a sanctioned event by Swimming Canada, nor by Aquatics Canada.

All Masters Swimming events in Ontario are not sanctioned by Swimming Canada. Any participants attending these events, in any capacity, are not covered by the policies, procedures or insurance of Swimming Canada and its members.

Unless advised in writing by Swimming Canada this notice of suspension remains indefinite.
