McDONALD'S USA-USSR DUAL SWIMMING MEET TO BE HELD AT THE UNIVERSITY OF TENNESSEE

The University of Tennessee's Student Aquatic Center will be the site of the McDonald's USA-USSR Dual Swimming Meet August 26-28, 1982. The meet will match the top swimmers of USA Swimming and the best from the Soviet Swimming Federation in head-to-head competition for both men and women. The swimming is scheduled each day from 2:00-4:00 p.m., with opening and closing ceremonies daily.

Frank Comfort, coach of the University of North Carolina's women's team, has been named the head coach of the USA National Team. Comfort guided his Lady Tar Heels to a third-place finish in the 1982 NCAA Championships, the fifth time in as many years at Chapel Hill that his team has placed in the top eight nationally. University of Tennessee's men's coach Ray Bussard will join Comfort's staff as an assistant coach. The swimmers for the USA National Team will not be selected until the United States Swimming Long Course Championships in Indianapolis, August 18-21.

The head coach of the strong Soviet team is Sergei Vaitsekhovsky, one of Russia's top mentors. Heading the list of the 35 Soviet swimmers is Olympic champion and world record holder Vladimir Salnikov, who has swum the world's fastest 400, 800 and 1500 meter freestyles.

Both teams will be staying on the University of Tennessee campus. The American team is scheduled to arrive in Knoxville on August 22, with the Soviet squad coming in the next day. In addition to their practice sessions at the Aquatic Center, the swimmers will have the opportunity to visit the 1982 World's Fair  $_{\rm TM}\,$  and Gatlinburg, Tennessee.

An official event of the 1982 World's Fair, the McDonald's meet will mark the sixth time the countries have met in dual competition. The first meet was held in 1967, with subsequent meets coming in 1971, 1977, 1978 and 1981. The United States leads the series 5-0. Below is a schedule of the competition:
