



The swimmers for the USA National Team will arrive in Knoxville Sunday, August 22 to compete in the McDonald's USA-USSR Dual Swimming Meet. The Americans are scheduled to land at McGhee Tyson Field's Old Terminal Building at 4:30 PM. The squad will be flying in from Indianapolis, where the members of the team will have been selected at the United States Swimming Long Course Championships.

The USA National Team will face the Soviet Swimming Federation's top athletes in dual competition August 26-28. The meet will be held at the University of Tennessee's Student Aquatic Center on the Tennessee campus. Events are scheduled to run each day from 2:00-4:00 PM.

The Soviet squad is expected to arrive on Monday. While in Knoxville, both teams will have the opportunity to visit Gatlinburg and the 1982 World's Fair, which is an official sponsor of the meet.
