21.2 Participation

- 21.2.1 Only delegations with athletes will be approved as official delegations to participate.
- 21.2.2 Only the following may participate as competitors in the Games:
 - a. Students who are currently officially registered as candidates for a degree or diploma at a similar university or institute, whose status is recognized by the corresponding national academic authority of their country.
 - b. Alumni of the institutions mentioned in a) who have obtained their academic degree or diploma in the year prior to the event.
 - c. Be a national/citizen of the country they represent (except for Football).
 - d. Born between January 1, 1996 to December 31, 2004.*

 *Age limit extended to 26 years of age in order to allow those who met the conditions in 2021 to take part in the FISU America Games 2022.
