

SELECTION CRITERIA

GENERAL PRINCIPLES

The National Technical Director selects the athletes.

It stops the nominative selection on the proposal of the Director of the French teams.

The National Technical Director may at any time remove from the list of selected athletes and/or sportswomen any swimmer who is not able to compete in optimal conditions in the competition for which he or she has been selected. retained, due to injury, pathology or medical contraindication.

After consultation with the technical management of the French team, the National Technical Director may, at any time, remove from the list of sportsmen and/or sportswomen selected, any swimmer or any swimmer who has shown reprehensible behavior (vis-à-vis national or international laws and regulations) or an attitude likely to hinder the proper functioning of the French team, or which could damage the image and values of this last and the French Swimming Federation.


No performance achieved at the start of a relay will be taken into consideration to integrate a national selection.

In the event of a tie for a selection, and if this case is not described in the selection criteria of the competition in reference, the swimmers will be decided on their performance in series, or failing that, on their best time of the event in the federal database of the 2023 national rankings in the 50 m pool, on the date of the selection.

Clarification concerning the wording: for reasons of editorial ease, each time it is written “swimmers...”, it should be understood as “swimmers and swimmers...”.

2. Selection Competition

The French Elite Championships from June 11 to 16.

3. Selection rules for individual events:

3.1 Will be proposed for selection, **within the limit of 2 swimmers per event**, during the competition referred to in **point 2**, the swimmers **who will have achieved in the A final (in series* for the 800 and 1500 freestyle events for women and men)** the qualifying time from the table below. In case of a tie for the 2nd qualifying place on an event, the time in series will be considered. In the event of a new tie, the best time achieved over the season will be considered.

3.2. In the event that two swimmers are not selected in an event, the time of the heats will eventually be considered.

4.1 Relays will be selected at the discretion of the DTN taking into account the load of the individual programs and the opportunities for each relay to perform, and/or qualify for individual finals. .

4.2 Reserve swimmers may be selected based on level and relay strategy.

4.3 The performances achieved during the competition referred to in **point 2** may be taken into account in the same order of priority as the individual events.

4.4 The selection of reservists is the responsibility of the Director of the French teams.

5. Complementary tests

With regard to the competition program and the swimmers selected, the possibility of committing to additional events is up to the decision of the Director of the French teams.

6. General provisions

6.1 All qualifications are made subject to adequate preparation to perform at this competition being planned.

6.2 Exemptions from the qualification process can only be granted by the National Technical Director.

2.1 Be licensed to the French University Sports Federation (FFSU) for the 2022/2023 season.

2.2 Participating MANDATORY in the French University Championships from xx to xx XX to XX.

2.3 Specific conditions for swimmers training abroad : participation in university events in their host country may be considered sufficient to enter the competition.

2.4 Specific conditions for swimmers who have completed their cycle of study by obtaining a university degree in 2020, 2021 and 2022: their selection may be proposed insofar as the World University Games are organized every two years.

In case of a tie for the 2nd qualifying place on an event, the time in series will be considered. In the event of a new tie, the best time achieved over the season will be considered.

4.2 The final decision remains subject to the discretion of the National Directors Selection Committee FFSU/FFN.

* time classification for the 800 and 1500 freestyle events for women and men when the program offers them in this format.

5. Selection rules for relay events:

5.1 Will be proposed for selection, **the first 4 swimmers**, who, during the competition referred to in **point 3**, **will have achieved in final A or B only** the qualification time of table n° 2 below, the times achieved in final A prevailing on those made in the B final.

5.2 Considering the times achieved during the competition referred to in **point 3**, the relay times in table N°2 will be calculated by adding the 4 best swimmers for each event, 4 different swimmers having to make up the medley relays.

5.3 If the times in table N°2 are achieved, the selection will be established according to the availability of the 4 best swimmers concerned and/or the level of the reservists.

5.4 Reserve swimmers may be selected based on relay level and strategy.

5.5 The selection of reservists will be proposed by the Director of the French teams to the selection committee of national directors FFSU/FFN.

6. Complementary tests

6.1 Swimmers selected for one or more individual events, provided that they participate in the event or events for which they have been qualified, may possibly be entered in one event or, at most, two additional events, within the limit places available, given the program and the interest of the team.

7.2 Exemptions from the qualification process can only be granted by the FFSU/FFN National Directors Selection Committee.



- 4.1** Will be proposed for selection, **the 4 best swimmers**, who, during the competition referred to in **point 2, will have achieved in the final A* only** the qualification time of table n°2 below.
- 4.2** Considering the times achieved during the competition referred to in **point 2 and with regard to point 4.1**, the relay times in table N°2 will be calculated by adding the 4 best swimmers for each event, 4 different swimmers having to constitute the 4 stroke relays.
- 4.3** If the times in table N°2 are achieved, the selection will be established according to the availability of the 4 best swimmers concerned and/or the level of the reservists.
- 4.4** Reserve swimmers may be selected based on level and relay strategy.

4. Selection rules for relay events:

- 4.1 With regard to point 3.2**, the selection times in Table No. 2 **are given for information only**. Under no circumstances will their realization constitute an “automatic” selection. The decision to engage relays will be taken according to the potential of the team, the program, and in the interest of the team of France .
- 4.2** Will be proposed for selection, **the 4 best swimmers**, who, during the competition referred to in **point 2.1, will have achieved**, in the order of priority described in **point 2.1**, the qualification time of table n°2 below, 4 different swimmers to make up the 4 medley relays.
- 4.3** If the quota described in **point 3.2** is not reached, swimmers not individually qualified may be offered for selection to constitute relays.
- 4.4** The 4 x 100 mixed freestyle and 4 x 100 mixed medley relays will eventually be offered for selection, depending on the swimmers **already selected**.
- 4.5 All selected swimmers are eligible for the relay title.**
- 4.6** The final decision remains subject to the discretion of the National Technical Director or his representative.

5. Complementary tests

- 5.1** The swimmers selected for one or more individual events, provided that they participate in the event or events for which they have been qualified, may possibly be entered in an event within the limits of the places available, in view of the program and interest of the team.
- 5.2** The order of access to these events will be based on the ranking of the events established at the best percentage of the IMPR.



3.2 The rules of the competition set the maximum number of participants per selection at 16 girls and 16 boys. In the event that this quota is exceeded, **the places will be decided** according to the number of events acquired individually and, where applicable, their best percentage of the World Benchmark Performance Index (IMPR).

3.3 In each event, the order of access to the selection will be based on the ranking of the best performances achieved.

3.4 Swimmers **very close** to the qualifying times, with regard to the provisions described in **points 3.1 and 3.2**, and in view of the opportunity to improve the potential of the team in the general classification, may be called upon to complete the selection.

3.5 The final decision remains subject to the discretion of the National Technical Director or his representative.

3.1 The French delegation will be composed of a **maximum of 24 swimmers** (male and female swimmers combined) qualified for the individual events according to the criteria described below.

3.2 Will be proposed for selection, **within the limit of 4 swimmers per event**, and with regard to **point 3.1**, the swimmers who will have achieved, during the competitions detailed in **point 2**, the qualification time of table n ° 1 below .

3.3 In the event **that more than 24 swimmers** have satisfied **point 3.2** and to meet the requirements of **point 3.1**, the best FINA 2023 ranking ranks in 50m pool or the best FINA 2022 ranking ranks in 25m pool will be used to determine the final selection.

3.4 In the event of equal FINA rankings in an event, the performance achieved in the 50m pool will take priority.

Editor's note: The **LEN** can modify the number of swimmers authorized to participate in an event. If this eventuality arises, **point 3.2** will be amended accordingly.

4. Selection rules for relay events:

4.1 Relays will be selected at the discretion of the DTN taking into account the load of the individual programs and the opportunities for each relay to perform, and/or qualify for individual finals. .

4.2 Reserve swimmers may be selected based on level and relay strategy.
