POSITION

On cash prizes awarded to Russian athletes, coaches and other swimming specialists for prizes in sports competitions in 2023

I. GENERAL PROVISIONS

1. Present Regulations "On prizes in cash awarded to Russian and other athletes coaches swimming specialists for prizes at sports competitions in 2023" (hereinafter - the Regulations) establishes the procedure for awarding prizes in cash to Russian athletes, coaches and other swimming specialists for prizes at sports competitions in 2023 and is aimed at stimulating Russian athletes to improve the level of sportsmanship, as well as their achievement of high sports results.
2. The Prize in cash (hereinafter referred to as the Prize) is understood to mean the payment - of cash awarded to athletes based on the results of entry into sports swimming competitions organized by the WFTU, as well as personal trainers of athletes and other specialists.

II. SCORING SYSTEM AND PRIZE AMOUNT

1. Prizes based on the results of each competition or group of competitions are established for athletes according to tables No. 1-4.

In the event that two or more athletes occupy the same prize place, the amount of the Prize is distributed between them in equal shares.

In the event of a tie in points, priority will be given to the athlete with the highest score in one of the clusters.

If equality is preserved a priority given sportsman, set one or more world records than his opponent.

If a tie still holds, priority will be given to the athlete whose world record has the highest ranking on the WA World Records table.

2. Prizes are also awarded to personal trainers and other professionals involved in the preparation of winners, prize-winners of competitions.

3. PRIZES ON THE RESULTS OF PERFORMANCE AT THE STAGES OF THE RUSSIAN SWIMMING CUP

Swimming Cup of Russia. 1st stage. 01 - 02 May, Yuzhno-Sakhalinsk
 Cup of Russia in swimming. 2nd stage. June 30 - July 02, Obninsk
 Russian Swimming Cup. 3rd stage July 04 - 05, Irkutsk

Based on the results of participation in each stage of the Russian Cup, winners are determined, regardless of gender, who showed the best 10 results according to the current International Aquatics Federation (WA) points table based on the sum of the two best results at any distances set in the final heats.

4. PRIZES ON THE RESULTS OF PERFORMANCE IN THE CLUSTER OF COMPETITIONS

I cluster

- April 16 - 21, Russian Swimming Championship, Kazan
- July 25 - 30, Russian Swimming Cup. The final. Kazan

II cluster:

- November 20 - 25, Russian Swimming Championship (25 m), St. Petersburg
- December 16 - 18, International swimming competitions "Vladimir Salnikov Cup", St. Petersburg

At the end of each cluster winners are determined separately among men and the women with the top 10 total scores based on the current International Aquatics Federation (WA) points table for the best results shown in any two distances set in the final heats in each of the two competitions in the same cluster.

The amount of the Relay Swimming Record Breaking Prize is divided by the number of participants in the relay that set the record.

With the simultaneous establishment of a world record, Europe, Russia is paid a prize for the highest achievement.

6. The basis for awarding the Prizes are:

- decision of the President of the WFTU - to the head coach of the swimming team, the head coach of the junior swimming team
- a written submission from the Head Coach of the Russian national team in swimming - personal trainers, head coaches (except for the head coach of the junior national team) and other specialists.

7. Prizes are awarded to athletes, coaches and other specialists in the following terms:

- by stages of the Russian Cup, by clusters of competitions - within three months from the date of the end of the competition;
- according to the records of the world, Europe, Russia - within three months from the date record approval

8. Prizes are awarded subject to strict compliance with the requirements of the Charter of the NGO "All-Russian Swimming Federation", decisions and other regulatory documents of the WFTU, the terms of sponsorship agreements, rules and regulations for holding All-Russian and international competitions, approved by the relevant competent bodies of the WFTU, the Federal executive authority in the field of physical culture and sports, anti-doping rules, Athlete Status Regulations, Specialist Status.

9. In case of improper fulfillment or non-fulfillment by athletes, coaches and other specialists of the current legislation, norms, rules, conditions of agreements specified in paragraph 5 of these Regulations, the WFTU Presidium has the right to decide to deprive the athlete, coach, other specialist of the Prize or reduce its size.

10. In the event that an athlete is held liable for an anti-doping violation, the athlete, as well as his personal trainer, must return the received prizes to the WFTU in accordance with these Regulations within 7 days from the date of receipt of the request from the WFTU.

11. By decision of the WFTU President, the WFTU employees are paid bonuses for fruitful, conscientious work to ensure the training and participation of Russian athletes in Russian and international competitions. The total amount of premiums shall not exceed 6,000,000 (Six million) rubles.
