The CCS Commissioner and/or staff have sole authority to schedule or cancel sites, as well as full discretion as to the assignment or reassignment of teams to times and sites throughout the CCS Play-offs. The CCS Commissioner and/or staff have the final authority in any disputes over sites or times of play, and the decision of the CCS Commissioner is not subject to appeal, due to the immediacy of running the Tournament for the good of the whole. Neutral sites are not a policy of the CCS and should not be expected in any rounds of play. Sites will be assigned by the CCS for the good of the Tournament.

IMPORTANT NOTICE TO ALL PARTICIPANTS AND COACHES

The CIF-Central Coast Section is well aware that many other school and non-school activities (AP tests, SAT/ACT tests, proms, plays, holidays, senior trips, religious days, etc.) may occur during CCS Play-offs. The CCS tries to avoid as many conflicts as possible; however, with so many activities available for today's student-athlete, it is not reasonable to assume that all such activities can be taken into account, and thus, CCS Play-off events will go on as originally scheduled. Participants and coaches are therefore expected to plan in advance for such possible scheduling conflicts and make those difficult choices as to which events will take precedence for that individual. Generally, although it is ultimately the personal choice of the student-athlete and/or his/her parent(s), an academic activity should take precedence over an extra-curricular event.

WARM-UP PROCEDURE

The warm-up procedure will be conducted in accordance with the SWIMMING & DIVING BYLAWS.

ENTRY DEADLINES & PROCEDURES:

The Central Coast Section will utilize Club Assistant for entry to the CCS Swimming & Diving Championships. Each individual school will be responsible for following the procedures for entry of their school's swimming and diving entries. It is recommended that the head coach perform this responsibility. It is also recommended that this entry responsibility is not delegated to another person or league representative. Both swimming and diving entries must be entered using the Club Assistant system. Entry instructions, including school usernames and passwords, will be emailed directly to each head coach by Club Assistant. If the head coach information has not provided to the CCS, the school username and password will be emailed to the athletic director. If you experience a problem with entries to Club Assistant, contact Nik Kikuta at ccsentries@att.net The deadline for entries is Monday, April 29, 2024 by 5:00 p.m. THERE WILL BE NO EXCEPTIONS.

No later than Monday, April 29, 2024, diving coaches must also register and submit a list of specific dives using www.divemeets.com. (Click here for instructions on how to register on Divemeets.com). Team dive sheets are supplemental to the entry process on Club Assistant; they are NOT a form of entry. Completed dive sheets must be submitted by 5:00 pm on Monday, April 29, 2023. MEET TIMERS

Timers for the meet will be determined based on entries. The list of timers will be posted on Tuesday, April 30. The coaches of the schools who will be timing will also be notified through email.

SCRATCH PROCEDURES

Swimming PRELIMINARIES: All scratches must be submitted to the Clerk of Course by: 3:00 pm, THURSDAY, MAY 2ND (Girls) and 3:00 pm, FRIDAY, MAY 3rd (Boys).

Swimming FINALS: All scratches must be submitted to the Referee by: 1:00 pm, SATURDAY, MAY 4th.

COACHES PACKET & PASSES

- All student athletes must be accompanied by a coach that meets the criteria as addressed in CIF Bylaws 308 & 506. Students who are not accompanied by a coach meeting these requirements at any CIF contest WILL BE CONSIDERED INELIGIBLE and will not be allowed to compete.
- Coaches Schools must submit coaches' names, email addresses and phone numbers to the meet director in advance using the form called "Deck Pass List. The form is available under the "Playoff Information & Bylaws" tab of the Swimming & Diving webpage of the CCS website. It must be signed by the principal and emailed to lebherzt@yahoo.com. The deck pass MUST be turned in by April 29, 2024.
- Please note that only two deck passes per gender, per school will be distributed.
- Coaches should pick up team packets, containing heat sheets and other critical Meet information at the Pass Gate upon arrival at the venue.
- Coaches will not be allowed on the deck area between the diving pool and the swimming pool.
- Only athletes, coaches and officials are allowed on the pool deck at any time.
- No team canopies will be allowed on the deck area or in the stands.

LOCKER ROOMS/TEAM MEMBERS' PERSONAL BELONGINGS

Neither the CCS, nor the host site, is responsible for your team member's personal property. Meet participants should NOT assume that there will be "full time" supervision of locker-room facilities during the Meet. Therefore, it is incumbent upon Meet participants to make their own arrangements for safeguarding their personnel's valuables. We strongly recommend that you do not leave ANY valuables in any locker room while you are on the deck. If you do so, you are doing so at your own risk.

USE OF AUDIO AND VIDEO

Use of any audio or visual recording devices, including but not limited to film and digital cameras, cell phones and tablets, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms. Violation of this recording prohibition may result in ejection from the swimming pool facility by the Meet Director or his designee. No drones are allowed in or around the venue.

TRAINER

There will be NO trainers provided at the CCS Swimming & Diving Championships.

RULES

The current NFHS Swimming & Diving Rules will be followed, except as modified by State CIF and CCS.

SPORTSMANSHIP

- SHAVE-DOWN: Shaving of any form will NOT be allowed at the Meet venue. This will be considered as UNSPORTSMANLIKE CONDUCT under Rule 3. Section 5., Article 7 of the NFHS Swimming & Diving Rules. Any participant in violation of this rule will be disqualified from further competition.
- **DECK-CHANGING:** Deck-changing will **NOT** be allowed at the Meet venue. This will be considered as UNSPORTSMANLIKE CONDUCT under Rule 3. Section 5., Article 1. of the NFHS Swimming & Diving Rules. Any participant in violation of this rule will be disqualified from further competition.
- The NFHS Uniforms Rule (Rule 3, Section 3, Article 1) will be strictly enforced for the <u>duration of the CCS Swimming & Diving Championships whenever participants are on the Championship premises.</u> Any infraction of this will be considered an unsportsmanlike act and a violation of the CCS Sportsmanship Policy.
- Any player or coach who is ejected from a CCS Tournament contest for FLAGRANT MISCONDUCT or UNSPORTSMANLIKE BEHAVIOR will be disgualified from all remaining contests in that sport that season.
- No two piece swimsuits will be allowed in the vicinity of the pools.

TEAM SCORING

As outlined in the CCS Swimming & Diving Bylaws, the meet will be scored to sixteen (16) places.

<u>RESULTS</u>

Live results will be linked under the "Brackets & Results" tab on the <u>CCS Swimming & Diving webpage</u> as will complete results upon completion of the meet. Meet mobile and Club Assistant -Swim time will have the results.

RADIO/TV LICENSING & MEDIA POLICIES

CCS owns the broadcasting rights for all championship contests. Licensing is required. The NFHS Network/Play-On Sports will be providing both Live and On-Demand coverage of the Meet Finals on the CCS/NFHS Network Portal.



Media intending to cover the CCS Swimming & Diving Championships must be credentialed by the CCS Commissioner well before the Tournament. *Unauthorized selling of photographs taken at CCS events is strictly prohibited. Please note:* Photographers will not be allowed behind the starting blocks.

COMMEMORATIVE T-SHIRTS & PATCHES

STATE CIF MEET:

The top three (3) placers in each event in the Boys and Girls Divisions qualify for the State CIF Swimming & Diving Meet at Clovis Olympic Swim Complex at Clovis West HS in Fresno, CA on May 9th - May 11th, 2024. Coaches who have athletes qualifying for the State Meet should refer to the State CIF website (www.cifstate.org) to download a copy of the CIF State Meet Championship Handbook.



<u>Note:</u> Any athlete who qualifies for the CIF State Meet but plans to scratch any event must notify the Meet Director at any time <u>prior to 30 minutes after the completion of the CCS Championship Meet</u> in order to complete their scratch and alert any potential alternate.
