





# Allegheny College



Allegheny College is one of the oldest schools in the nation, founded in 1815, and in "business" for our 160th year.

Allegheny has traditionally drawn the majority of its student body from Western Pennsylvania, although nearly every state and 10 foreign nations are represented by the current student body.

Allegheny has always subscribed to a high quality of education, and its premedicine and pre-law schools are nationally recognized for their academic excellence.

### Student Concerns

Approximately half of Allegheny's 1,815 undergraduates qualify for (and get) financial assistance in the form of scholarships (except athletic), grants or loans (many of them from outside sources), or a combination thereof.

Allegheny's educational philosophy focuses on the importance and uniqueness of each individual, and the academic program has been designed to accomplish this objective. Underlying the College's approach is the recognition that no single academic plan accomodates the needs of each person and that flexibility and choice are both desirable and necessary.

Students, working in close cooperation with faculty advisors, develop personalized programs of study ranging from the traditional to the highly innovative. No specific courses are required of any student. However, general guidelines exist to ensure the proper blend and distribution of liberal arts experiences, courses in the area of concentration, and electives. Course work in the proposed major may be included in the freshman schedule, while the undecided student may explore a wide variety of subject areas during the first two years.

The three-term, three-course academic calendar which encourages uninterrupted, concentrated, in-depth study provides the vehicle for the learning experience. Vacations are scheduled between terms rather than within terms.

Counseling, guidance, and frequent interaction with the faculty are fundamental to the entire program.

The Allegheny campus, aesthetically one of the leading campuses in the nation, serves as the center for the College's student life.

# Championships

# **In Three Divisions**

National

At its first special Convention in August 1973, the NCAA voted to establish national championship competition in each of three divisions for its active institutional membership of 676 (of a total membership of 796).

Each institution was afforded the opportunity to select its division through the process of self-determination except in the sport of football. Currently 236 members are Division I, 179 Division II and 261 Division III.

Members which have designated Division II or Division III may elect to compete in Division I in one sport except football or basketball.

All member institutions are eligible for championship competition in the sports of fencing, ice hockey, skiing, indoor track, volleyball and water polo.

In any sport in which championship competition is not offered for Division III, those member institutions are eligible to compete in the Division II Championships. In addition to the seventeen National Collegiate Championships, twelve meets and tournaments will be conducted in Division II and eight championships will be held for Division III members.


No later than the 1975-76 academic year, the NCAA will sponsor at least 39 championships with at least 10 in each division.

# **Division III Swimming Preview**

Meadville, Pennsylvania is not a likely place to start something, but in the town's 187 year history, Meadville has been for starting a lot of things. Among the best known is the first direct primary election of town officials in U.S. history. This year, celebrating Allegheny College's 160th anniversary, Meadville is adding another first to its list of credits. The National Collegiate Athletic Association Swimming and Diving Championships for Division III will be held for the first time in Allegheny's new 25-yard pool.



Amid much publicity last year the NCAA discarded the University and College division classifications and adopted Division I, II and III. The Division III championship was to be held in 1976, but Allegheny offered to host the meet this year and at the January NCAA meeting, their bid was approved.

The meet was designed to offer competition for the swimmer in the small colleges. However, a survey of the nation's fastest times this year by Division II and III swimmers show over half performed by Division III swimmers. At press time, nine of the top twelve times including three of the top four in the 50 yard freestyle were made by Division III swimmers. It was necessary to change the time standards for the meet in the middle of the season because of the excellence of the Division III swimmers.

The NCAA championships, regardless of the sport or division, have always been the highlight of the college season. The meet follows strict regulations; swimmers being allowed to enter a maximum of three individual and three relay events over the three day span of the meet providing they have met the championship qualifying time standards. Scoring is through 12 places, relays counting double. Team spirit, always high for a championship, will play even a bigger part this year because every winner could be setting a record.

Chico State University, California, is the favored team. Coach Ernie Maglischo's squad is big, tough and deep. Chico won the College division championships for the last two years and has recruited well this year. Returning are NCAA champions Chris Webb, Pete Hovland and the 400 and 800 yard freestyle relays. Adding to team depth will be Art Hickey, Jim Barry, Larry Gates, Stu Kahn, Gary Stiefvater, Russ Fellezs and Gary Swenor. Johns Hopkins with Mark Horning and Monmouth, led by Bill Kiss and Don Asay, are possible challengers but will probably finish far behind Chico. Here is a rundown of what to expect:

### 500 yard Freestyle

John Hudson, a local boy from Millersville, Pennsylvania who is a freshman at Washington and Lee, is the pick as he has already clocked 4:44.27 for the event. That time is faster than the 1974 winner of the College Division meet. Larry Gates, Chico, has a chance to move into the winner's circle if Hudson folds. Art Hickey, Chico, and Don Asay of Monmouth cannot be counted out. Other possible championship finalists include Eric Engelmann, Johns Hopkins; Jeff McBride, Bowdoin; and Stu Kahn, Chico.

### 200 yard Individual Medley

Mark Horning, Johns Hopkins, is a hands down favorite to win this event. Horning is over two seconds ahead of his challenger, Gary Stiefvater of Chico. Stiefvater is extremely tough in the national championships though, and could be an upset winner. James Bush, St. Lawrence; Jeff Walling, Monmouth; David Thurber, Bowdoin; and Rick Hinrichs, Oberlin, are given a chance to upset the form chart.

### 50 yard Freestyle

If there is an event that is harder than any other to pick, this is the one. Jack Grosell, Hiram, has blitzed the field with an amazing 21.2. Jesse de la Rama, Amherst, and Chris Webb, Chico, were third and fourth in last year's meet and are ranked this year. Other contenders for the title include Scott White, Illinois-Chicago Circle; A. Morse, Widner; Dick Ferrin, Brooklyn College; and Greg Bissell who will be swimming in front of his own fans at the Allegheny pool.

### 400 yard Medley Relay

Chico will have to replace two men on their second place medley relay from last year's championships to repeat in 1975. However, with a large freshman class to



pick from, finding a backstroker and a butterflier shouldn't be that hard. Russ Fellezs will probably replace the missing flier leaving only the backstroke leg unsettled. If Coach Maglischo's backstroker fails, Monmouth, Johns Hopkins, Williams or Wabash will move into the number one spot on the victory stand.

### 400 yard Individual Medley

Gary Stiefvater, Chico, and Martin Pfinnsgraff, another Allegheny swimmer who will have the home town fans cheering for him, are the only finalists from last year's meet returning. Stiefvater is the favorite if Mark Horning decides not to swim the event. James Bush, St. Lawrence; Tom Stenovec, Johns Hopkins; and Jim Barry, Chico all rate a chance at being a winner.

### 200 yard Freestyle

Toss a coin and take your pick for the winner of this event. Last year's champion Pete Hovland, Chico, returns but so does third place Chris Webb, Chico; fifth place, Bill Kiss, Monmouth; and eighth place Stu Kahn, Chico. Add freshman Larry Gates, Chico, leader in the national rankings in this event, and John Hudson, Washington and Lee, and there should be a real donneybrook that will leave the waters steaming. Jeff Cook, St. Lawrence, has an outside chance at winning.

### 100 yard Butterfly

Bill Milne, 1974 All-American from Johns Hopkins, has graduated. That opens up the butterfly events, Milne's private hunting preserve for the last two years. Dwight Davis, Ashland, is the sole underclassman in last year's top twelve returning so that means that there will be a lot of new faces on the victory stand. With teammate Milne graduated, Mark Horning will probably return to the fly events where he swims better. Don Asay, Monmouth, could win this event but will probably not swim it. Wayne Lawrence, Hiram; Scott Hartley, Coast Guard; Russ Fellezs, Chico; Dan Scheerer, Wabash; and Will Brotherton, Washington and Lee, will fight it out among themselves with maybe a freestyle sprinter trying his skill on a day that has no freestyle sprints scheduled.

### 100 yard Backstroke

Mark Horning, Johns Hopkins, is again a

favorite if he swims the event instead of the 100 fly. Horning has improved so much from last year that his number of victories in the championship is limited only by the event limit rule. Coach Frank Comfort will probably place Horning in the fly, even though he has been a championship finalist in the backstroke for the last two years. This will allow John Dierkes, Horning's teammate, to move up in the standings. Eric Gerstein, Bethany; Peter De Golia, Colorado College; Scott Jeff Walling, Schumacker, Williams: Monmouth; and JOe Gawrys of Wabash College are all equally talented and any of these swimmers could eventually be the winner.

### 100 yard Breastroke

Jeff Carlberg, Hamilton, won the event last year and has to be a favorite to retainhis title. Haru Naito, S.U.N.Y. Oneonta, returns for his last crack at regaining the crown he lost last year to Carlberg. Rick Hinrichs, Oberlin; Gary Swenor, Chico, and Paul Von Eigen, Williams will threaten if Carlberg has another bad start as in last year's finals. Scott White, Illinois-Chicago Circle, could win based on the 1:00.14 clocking posted earlier this season but he will have to repeat the time to edge Carlberg.

### 800 yard Freestyle Relay

Chico State won the event last year by six seonds and replaced their only slow leg with a freshman who can swim four seconds faster. Need anything more be said? Monmouth, Johns Hopkins, Washington and Lee and Bowdoin will be in a fight for second.

### 1650 yard Freestyle

John Hudson, Washington and Lee, might be going for his third title of the meet in this event, but he will have to battle Art Hickey, Chico, all the way. The winner could well be below the College Division record of 16:19.85. Eric Engelmann, Johns Hopkins; John Davis, Kenyon; JIm Barry, Tom Curley, Dave Give and Bob Madrigo, all of Chico will challenge for the third spot.

### 100 yard Freestyle

Chris Webb and Pete Hovland of Chico and Bill Kiss, Monmouth, return from last year's finalists. However, Jesse de la Rama, Amherst, and Larry Gates, Chico, cannot be ignored. De la Rama and Kiss are tied for the fastest time in Division III going into the meet, but with a national title at stake, anyone could get hot and take the win. Other championship finalists could include Richard Redall, Bowdoin; Dick Ferrin, Brooklyn College; Pete Hovland, Chico, and Phil Wild, Williams.

### 200 yard Backstroke

Again it's Mark Horning if he wants to swim the event. He is top ranked in both the backstroke and the butterfly and his choice will be based on where his teammates can place. Scott Schumacker, Williams, and Jeff Walling, Monmouth, are ranked close behind Horning, but the big suprise might be Peter De Golia, Colorado College; when he comes down from the 7,000 foot altitude to compete closer to sea Joe Gawrys, Wabash; David level. Thurber, Bowdoin; and a pair of swimmers, Ken Bailey and Bill Vitaletti from S.U.N.Y. Oneonta, might move up into the finalists.

### 200 yard Breastroke

Rick Hinrichs, Oberlin, is the highest ranked swimmer from last year to return. Jeff Carlberg, Hamilton, has been leading the 1975 ranking lists all year by more than two seconds and is favored. Gary Swenor and Gary Stiefvater of Chico; Haru Naito, S.U.N.Y. Oneonta; Rick Goodele, Johns Hopkins; and Paul Von Eigen, Williams, will trail.

### 200 yard Butterfly

Mark Horning is the class of the event, having posted a time that is three seconds better than anyone else returning. The fight for second and third will be between Don Asay, Monmouth; Russ Fellezs and Stu Kahn of Chico; Dan Scheerer, Wabash; Wayne Lawrence, Hiram; Scott Hartley, Coast Guard; and Mark Fette, Ashland.

### 400 yard Freestyle Relay

The 400 yard freestyle relay is the last event of the program and Chico will close with a bang. Once again they have replaced the slowest leg on the 1974 winning relay with a much faster swimmer so Chico should really roll this year. Johns Hopkins and Monmouth will fight it out for second with Bowdoin, Amherst and Washington and Lee. All have only one super-fast leg on the relay, but Chico State has four. Get set Coach Maglischo for your annual "bath."

All of the forecasts are based on the current best times posted by the swimmers this season. The degree of taper, rest and shaving down for the conference meets that a team undertakes could all affect the performances at the championships. The meet is the first in the history of Division III and you can rest assured that the swimmers will do everything in their power to make it the best.






